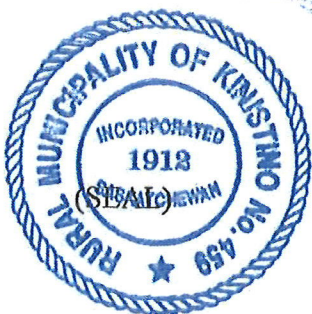
A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 84-2 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Kinistino in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No.84-2 as follows:

1. PART IV Definitions is amended by adding the following definition:
Immediate relative – shall mean grandparents, parents, siblings and children;

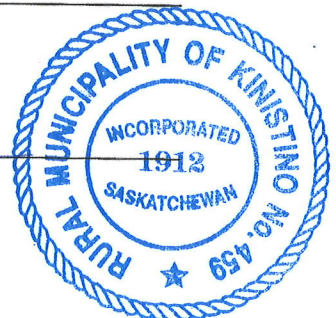
and
2. PART VI – Zoning District Schedules, Section 1.2.6 h) Uses Permitted at Council’s Discretion is amended by correcting the reference to Section 1.3.6 to 1.3.5;

and
3. PART VI – Zoning District Schedules, Section 1.3.3 – Number of Dwellings is amended by deleting the remaining portion of the sentence appearing after “land” and substituting the following:
“except:
(a) where additional dwellings are approved by Council intended to accommodate full time workers engaged in a principal agricultural use of the land;
(b) to permit one additional single detached dwelling that was previously used in conjunction with a farmstead;
(c) to permit one additional single detached dwelling on an approved non-farm residential site to accommodate an immediate relative provided the site has a minimum area of 1 hectare (2.4 acres)”.
4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister.

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Kinistino No. 459 intends to adopt a bylaw under The Planning and Development Act, 2007 to amend Bylaw 84-2, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

INTENT

The proposed bylaw will take care of a house-keeping item and allow for two non-farm residential sites on one yard-site for immediate relatives of the principle use.

REASON

The reason for the amendment is to allow pre-existing farm yard sites where there may be two residences to be allowed as a non-Farm residential use and to allow an immediate family member to have a second dwelling on a non-Farm site at the discretion of council.

PUBLIC INSPECTION

Any person may inspect the bylaw at the municipal office located in Kinistino, Saskatchewan between 8:30 a.m. - 12 noon and 12:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Monday through to Friday excluding statutory holidays. Copies are available at cost.

PUBLIC HEARING

Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday June 28th, 2011 at 8:00 a.m. at the municipal office council chamber to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed bylaw. Council will also consider written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the Administrator at the municipal office before the hearing.
